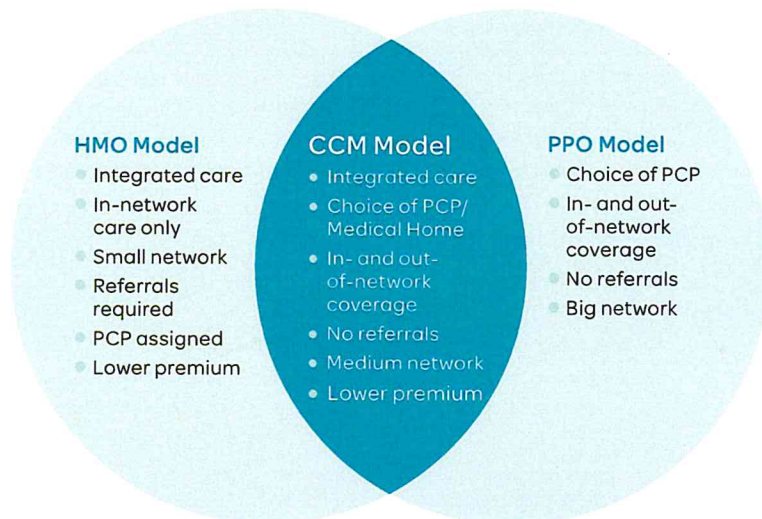


CCM: Coordinated care just for you
