Dear Culver Parent,

The Walk Out event that will be occurring this Wednesday, March 14th, at 10 a.m. is an opportunity for students to stand in unity and support of the high school and victims' friends and families of the Stoneman Douglas High School shooting that occurred a month ago.

Schools across the nation are organizing a Walk Out at 10 am local time that will last 17 minutes in honor of the victims of the recent shooting. While this is a non-district sponsored event, students will be supervised should they choose to participate in the student-initiated walkout. Students have a constitutional right to free speech at school, so long as it does not disrupt the learning environment for others. Students are welcome to participate.

At 10 a.m., the Walk Out will commence for 17 silent minutes and students will meet at the flagpole area on the west side of the school for the remainder of the time. Students are welcome to create and hold their own signs, and are encouraged to wear the color Maroon on Wednesday as an additional form to show support whether they walk out or not.

The terms for this event are:

- Students must prearrange with their teachers prior to the Walk Out.
- Students must leave their phones, backpacks, and any other personal items or electronic devices in their classrooms.
- Appropriate conduct from the students is expected at all times.
- No one will leave the Walk Out area early.
- Students who wish to participate may do so by adding their name to the list of students wanting to participate.

If students are not on the list, they will not be allowed to join the Walk Out.

To add names to the list they can either sign up with the link attached below, or let either Katy or Mrs. Nitschelm know. I am requesting that teachers add the link to their Google Classrooms so students are able to easily access the form and sign up before Wednesday. On Wednesday morning during advisory, a few student organizers will pass by each Advisory classroom to add any last-minute names to the list of participants. All lists need to be forwarded to Mrs. Nitschelm immediately after Advisory.
